Tullio Fanelli is a Member of the Regulatory Authority for Electricity and Gas since December 2003.

He was born in Foggia on 25 December 1956. He has a degree in nuclear engineering from Università di Roma "La Sapienza".

He spent his career at ENEA (Italy's National Agency for New Technologies, Energy and the Environment) and at the Italian Ministry for Productive Activities, first as head of the Technical-Operational Secretariat and then as Director General for Energy and Mineral Resources.

Among other assignments, he has served as: member of the Italian Committee of Research Experts for the Electricity Sector; member of the boards of GRTN (the Italian ISO) and SOGIN; Chairman of Italy's Inter-Ministerial Council for Questions Regarding the Peaceful Use of Nuclear Energy; Chairman of the National Committee for Security of Natural Gas Supply; and Chairman of the Technical Committee for the Restructuring of the Fuel Distribution Network.
